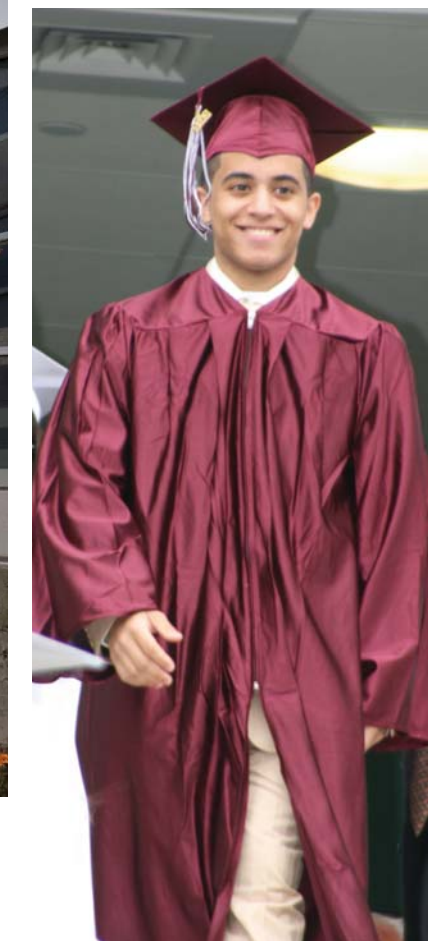


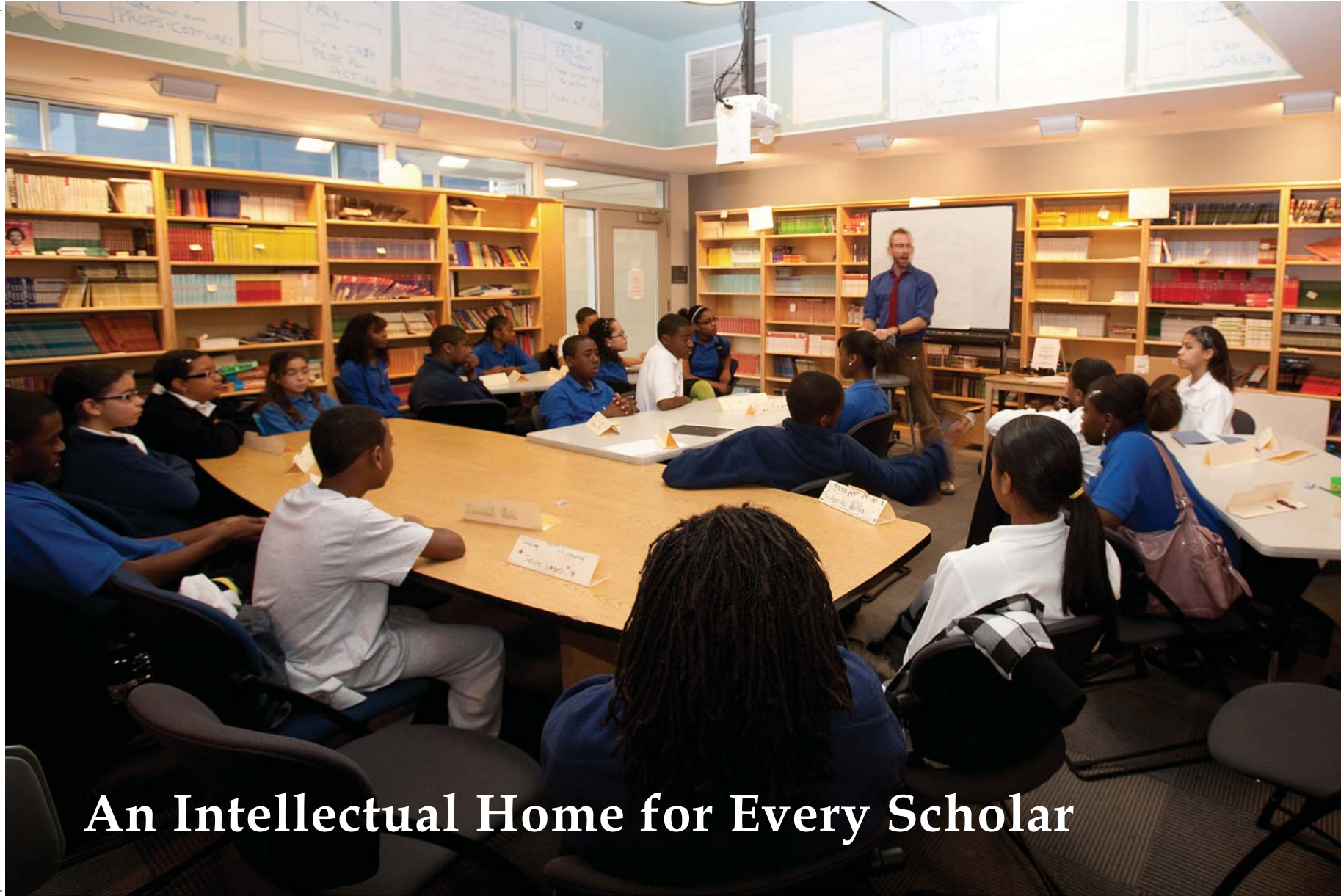

From humble beginnings, renting eight classrooms in a church basement in September 2000, we now have our own \$20 million state-of-the-art facility that serves a student body that has grown from 100 to 700. Every student who has graduated from Bronx Prep has earned an acceptance into college.

Today, our graduates attend more than 40 colleges across the country, including Stanford, MIT, Swarthmore, Georgetown, Howard, Wellesley, and various SUNY and CUNY schools.

Our school operates on an extended-day and extended-year schedule. Active Teaching and Learning



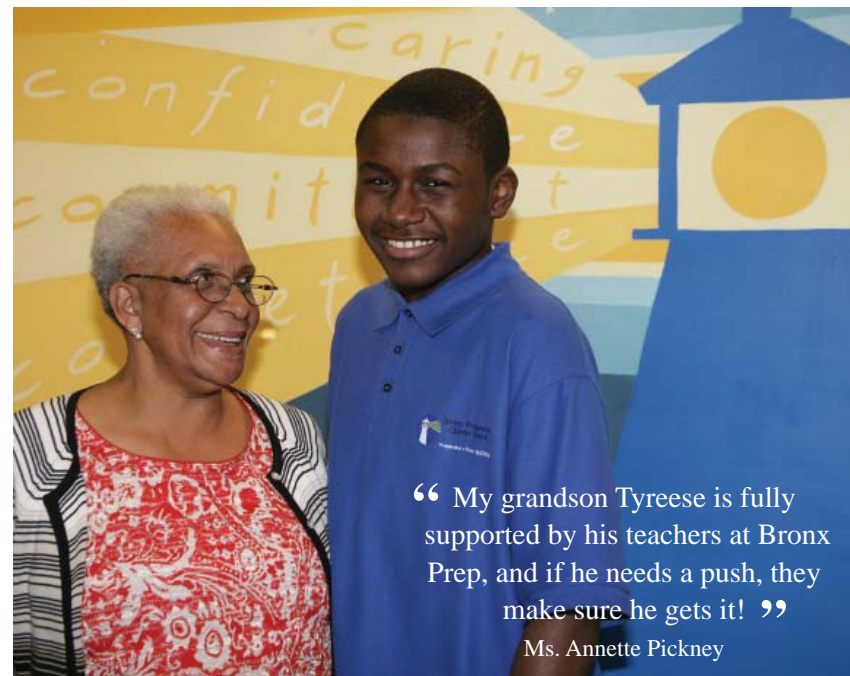
Teachers foster student independence and create opportunities for personal, social, and academic achievement. We equip our students to make informed choices at school, at home, and in the world beyond.
